How to Walk This Out

- Practice proximity: 10 minutes a day—Word open, heart open.
- Pray first, not last: "Lord, what's my courageous next step?"
- Active waiting: prepare like the answer is on the way.
- Stand steady: choose integrity over approval.
- Rise again: repentance → realignment → resilience.
- One-line rule: Pressure doesn't define me—God's presence does.
